You are solely responsible for maintaining your private well. Knowing the water quality of your well is the first step in protecting your family. Take advantage of UCCD's annual well water testing day to test your well water!

Taking your sample on April 28th is <u>critical</u> as some tests must be analyzed within a short holding time.

Important Dates to Remember

* Must <u>pre-register</u> by 3pm on Wednesday, <u>April 16</u>, including which test option you would like — call 307-288-0214 or register online. *Payment is due at time* of pre-registration.

Bridger Valley-pick up your sampling kit from the UCCD Office April 21-24, from 8am-4pm.

Evanston -pick up your sampling kit from the UW Extension Office during their business hours April 21-25.

* <u>Sample your water on April 28</u> and bring the sample back to the Conservation District in Lyman by 9am, or the UW Extension Office in Evanston by 10am, the same morning you sample. All samples must be back to one of these locations by the time listed, on April 28!

Conservation District Office: 204 East Sage Street, Lyman, WY

University of Wyoming Extension Office: 228 9th Street, Evanston, WY

Samples must be collected the morning of April 28 and brought to the drop off location before the time listed. UCCD will then put them on ice and take them to the lab in Layton, Utah, This ensures the samples arrive at the lab within the holding time.



Results of your well water test will be emailed directly to you from the lab. UCCD will not have access to your test results. <u>Results of the Full Well Test could</u> take up to 2 months to get back.
